Why we want you

Fairtrade is a movement for change that works directly with businesses, consumers and campaigners to make trade deliver for farmers and workers. Fairtrade is a global movement with a strong and active presence in the UK, represented by the Fairtrade Foundation. The international Fairtrade system (of which the Fairtrade Foundation is a member) works on behalf of farmers and workers to drive sustainable livelihoods, empower producers and workers, and make trade fair.

The Commercial Partnerships Team works with consumer-facing brands and retailers to support them with their Fairtrade commitments. Some of these partners include Greggs, Starbucks, Waitrose and Ben & Jerrys. The team is made up of four channels; Hot Beverages, Cocoa, Retail and FMCG (Fast Moving Consumer Goods). This volunteer position will primarily be supporting the Hot Beverages Channel.

Ideally we are looking for a volunteer for 0.5-1 day a week for at least 3 months. The role can be undertaken in the office or remotely. This arrangement is not intended to be legally binding or to create a contract.

What you will be doing

- Researching upcoming events, for contact attendance and speaking opportunities.
- Scoping the feasibility to engage with potential partners based on preidentified criteria.
- Contact mapping and lead generation.
- Initiating contact with cold lead if of interest.
